Never share your 12- or 24-word recovery phrase, passwords, or private keys with anyone—even someone claiming to be support.

What To Do If You Encounter a Scam

If you receive calls or messages claiming to be Trust Wallet support, here's what you should do:

Hang up or ignore the message immediately.

Report the scam to Trust Wallet via their official channels.

Warn others in the community by posting about the scam on forums or social media.

Review your wallet security—consider moving funds to a new wallet if your recovery phrase was compromised.
